

Just as ride leaders have a responsibility for the rides and riders they lead, riders have a responsibility to both the ride leader and the cycling community at large to ride in a responsible manner. This includes:

- Read the ride description and be familiar with the basics of the route
- Be able to ride at the posted average pace
- Communicate any issues you may have in regards to the route, or needing to cut off early, etc. prior to the ride
- Bring proper tools to take care of common on the ride issues (pump, spare tube, tire levers, etc)
- Point out road hazards to your fellow riders whether through hand signals or voice communication
- Follow traffic laws in a safe manner:
 - Ride no more than double file and move into single file when there's traffic behind
 - Yield to traffic behind
 - Don't run stoplights and stop signs
 - Don't ride the wrong way down one way streets
